01

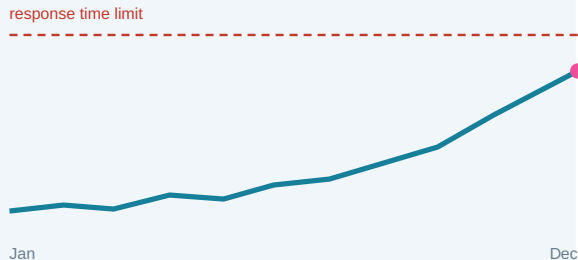

Response time, twelve months

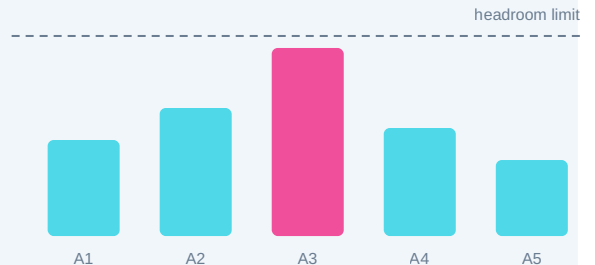
the creep no single measurement shows



Read: response time drifting toward the limit. Flagged as a trend, months before it would surface as an incident.

Utilisation across arrays

where capacity sits idle, and where it does not



Read: one array near its ceiling while others sit on headroom. Rebalance before buying, not after.

IN THREE STEPS

Get your assessment in motion.

01

It starts with a kick-off, where we agree on the questions your reading should answer.

02

We observe one cycle, about a month, long enough to see how your storage really behaves.

03

Then your reading: where you stand and what to act on, presented face-to-face.

GOOD TO KNOW

Nothing new to install

Already running IOportal or SAM4H? The collection is in place, and a reading can draw on all the history you have.

No history required

One observation cycle is enough for the first reading, and you are compared against the field from day one.

Repeat it, or not

Take a single reading, repeat it every quarter or half year, or run one on the history you already have.
